The Agency is an affiliate of the National Urban League founded in 1910, which is the premier social service and civil rights organization in the United States of America.



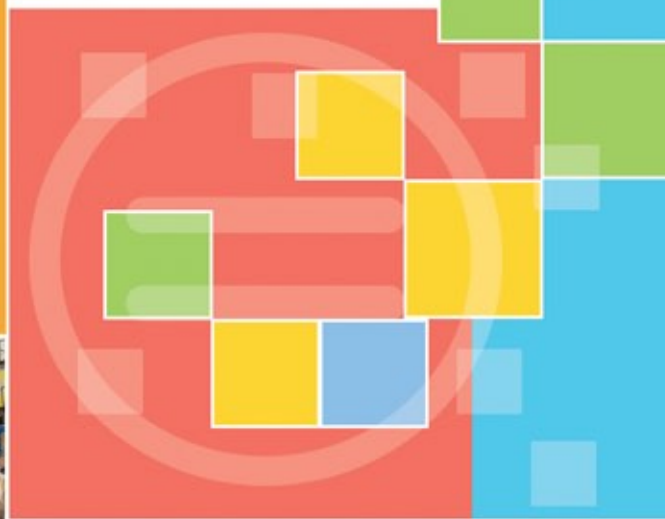
# Welcome!

Our program works in conjunction with the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services (DWSS) and the Children's Cabinet to connect our children and families with access to a variety of quality child care programs and resources.



## Our goals are to help you

The Las Vegas Urban League's Child Care Subsidy Program's goal is to provide affordable, accessible, reliable, caring, safe, and stimulating child care for the children of Southern Nevada by connecting the children and families to a network of community partners and customer driven programs. We provide service that is SMART. (Service, Maximize, Access, Respect and Timeliness)



## Community Partnering

The Las Vegas Urban League, in conjunction with DWSS (Department of Welfare and Supportive Services) and the Children's Cabinet, ensures that health and safety standards are practiced for all children who receive child care, regardless of choice, type or locality of their preferred provider. We work with other child care focused agencies to find families solutions to their most urgent child care needs while maintaining options and accessibility for many diverse lifestyles.

## Resource and Referral Program

We partner with the Children's Cabinet who help families locate licensed child care facilities that are close to home, work or in areas of their choice. The program is designed to inform and educate parents about areas of concern they may have about quality services and programs for their children.

CCR&R provides an entry point to the child care field by helping providers become licensed and achieve their initial and ongoing training and education goals. Once licensed, ongoing support to maintain and/or increase the quality of care is provided.
