



Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Nevada Drug Card?

Nevada Drug Card is a FREE statewide discount prescription assistance program. The program was launched to help uninsured residents afford their prescriptions.

Who is eligible to participate in the Nevada Drug Card program?

Every resident of Nevada is eligible to receive a FREE prescription drug card.

How do Nevada residents get a Nevada Drug Card?

Residents can print a card by visiting the program's website at www.nevadadrugcard.com. There will also be distribution sites set up across the state where residents can obtain a free card. Anyone not able to print, or otherwise obtain a card, can simply visit any Albertsons/Sav-on Pharmacy in Nevada and ask the pharmacist to have the prescription process through the Nevada Drug Card.

What are some of the highlights of the Nevada Drug Card?

- No enrollment forms
- No restrictions to participation
- No eligibility or income requirements/limitations
- No waiting periods
- No age restrictions
- No exclusions
- Includes pre-existing conditions
- No claim forms to file
- No annual or lifetime limits
- Includes discounts on brand and generic medications
- Open formulary so that all medications are eligible for discounts
- Confidentiality: No personal information will be sold, shared, or distributed.

What type of discounts can you expect when you use this card?

Average savings are roughly 30% with savings on some medications as high as 75%.

How can Nevada Drug Card provide free prescription assistance cards to residents?

This statewide prescription assistance program is made possible through the support of pharmacies and pharmaceutical companies.

Can this program be used by people who have insurance with prescription benefits?

Yes, this card can be used by people with insurance to discount non-covered drugs. This program is compatible with most insurance policies.

Will this card help people on Medicare Part D Plans?

Yes, the card can be used on cover non-covered medications – medications not on one’s Part D Plan.

What prescriptions are discounted with this program?

This program has a "LOWEST PRICE" feature that provides cardholders the lowest plan price on prescriptions at participating pharmacies (Medication Pricing/Discounts are calculated on the plans lowest negotiated contract price and the pharmacy’s “usual and customary” price). Can you provide a brief explanation of the Nevada Drug Card?

- The cards are FREE to all Nevada residents.
- The program offers discounts on brand/generic medications at participating retail pharmacy locations (over 50,000 pharmacies across the U.S.)
- This program is funded through the support of pharmacies and drug companies.
- There are no enrollment forms, no restrictions, no age or income requirements, no waiting periods, no eligibility required, no exclusions, covers pre-existing conditions, no claim forms to file, no annual or lifetime limits, includes discounts on brand and generic medications, open formulary so that all medications are eligible for discounts.
- This program has a "LOWEST PRICE" feature that provides cardholders the lowest plan price on prescriptions at participating pharmacies (Medication Pricing/Discounts are calculated on the plans lowest negotiated contract price and the pharmacy's "usual and customary" price).
- This program can be used by people who have Health Savings Accounts (HSAs), High Deductible Plans, and Medicare Part D.
- The program can be used as a standalone benefit or to get discounts on non-covered medications.
- All Nevada residents are eligible to participate in this program.
